This program offers the students the chance to experience the work on an archaeological site, working together with the research group of the URV who has been working on the site since the year 2000.

The protohistoric site of Assut is located closed to the Ebre river, in a privileged location that allowed its inhabitants to be in touch with the Mediterranean, Phoenician, Greek, Carthaginian and Roman civilizations, that were present in the Catalan coast through the VII and I centuries B.C.

The course is aimed at students with a background in History, Art History, Archaeology or related studies.
